Thematic cartography is one of the most important directions of the modern cartography

as it address a wide variety of new topics.

Imereti's key location in Georgia together with its socioeconomic and territorial

conditions contributes to the development of tourism in the region.

The main objective of the paper is to contribute to the development of scientific tourism in

Imereti region by linking these two major factors using the thematic cartography method.

The goal is achieved by using the traditional cartographic and geoinformation methods of

the research. Thought the working process, literature and cartographic materials on the

Imereti region were analyzed.

Finally, based on the information collected, the ecological basis of the research area was

prepared at 1: 200,000 scale. The mapping and geoinformation system of scientific tourism
