

Summary

The aim of this paper is to analyze “Georgian General Map” by Aleksandre Javakhishvili published in 1931-1932. As a result of the research change of state border and territorial arrangement of Georgia, a number of the peculiarities of demographic and territorial distribution of 1930s have been analyzed. The paper describes the borders of administrative units of Georgia, which are compared with the modern borders in detail.

In the result of the study, the important changes occurred in the administrative arrangement of Georgia which is implied on the one hand in changes in the number of administrative units, their area and borders has been identified after 1930s. The change of some administrative units from the point of toponimic view has been established as well.

The obtained results are reflected in the paper as thematic maps and diagrams.
